FAQs:

*What time and where does my child need to arrive for rehearsal on Sunday mornings when the choir is singing?*

10:15 a.m. is the robing time, unless it is a very special Sunday such as Easter or Advent (announced in advance), then 10:00 a.m. is the robing time. The robing and rehearsal room will be announced the week before the children's choir sings.

*Does my child need to wear anything special on Sundays when the choir is singing?*

Please have your child wear comfortable, preferably dark (black or dark brown) shoes, and dark colored stockings (girls) or socks (boys). The children wear choir robes so there is no need to wear anything too fancy.

*Does my child need to come to both Sunday and Wednesday rehearsals to be in the choir?*

No, but children are encouraged to come to as many rehearsals as possible before a singing Sunday (generally 3 or 4 is a minimum expectation) so they know the anthem and hymns well enough to be comfortable and have a positive singing experience. If you are unsure that your child can attend enough rehearsals before a singing Sunday or are unsure about your child's level of preparation, please contact Heather Fetrow, children's choir director.

*What should I do if my child has to miss rehearsal on a Wednesday or Sunday or a singing Sunday?*
